President's address

Thank you Hony Secretary Sh Sandeep Shrivastava

Council meeting is invaluable, especially in challenging times, as it offers a platform for understanding healing and growth.

I requested the house to maintain silence and extend full cooperation with the dais. We have already experienced a delay of one hour. I request the host branch to grant us permission to extend the session by an additional half an hour to ensure that the agenda is accommodated as comprehensively as possible.

I welcome you all in the Sun City of Jodhpur and also those seated at the back, who are not council members but are valued members and esteemed builders of our Association, I welcome them, Council members, Special invitees, Chairmen & Secretaries of Branches, I had hoped that Mr. Naresh Dave would be able to join us today after recovering from his bad health but it seems it was not possible for him to be here. I also take pride by welcoming all Patron members present and Past Presidents Sh Anil Raizada, Sh Varinder Garg, Sh Bharat Bhasin, Sh Lakhbir Singh, Sh Praveen Mahana and immediate Past President Sh Anil Kapoor, who graciously passed the baton of leadership to me of this esteemed Association. As we approach its 50th year, it is both a proud privilege and a great honour for me to carry forward its legacy. I would also like to express my heartfelt gratitude to all the office bearers and members of Jodhpur Branch for hosting this meeting and for extending such warm hospitality to all the delegates. Acting Chairman Shri Kailash Kachhwaha, Hony Secretary Sh Harish Sharma and senior member Ex CEC & convener Respected Shri Rajeev Chowdhery.

We pray to Almighty for wellness and success of all members and their families. Our Association has always been committed to foster well-being and resilience among our members. This meeting is yet another step towards empowering each of you for guidance and support. We believe that when we work together, facing challenges as a united front, we create an environment where everyone can thrive. I would like to share that I have been in touch with officials from various regions, including Andaman, Srinagar, Goa as well as the North-Eastern and Southern state.

I request everyone to be respectful while on the floor. No personal remarks should be passed and no cross talks. Be brief and avoid repetition of issues/views. This is also a time for us to listen carefully to your concerns, your suggestions, and your aspiration. Together, we aim to create actionable solutions that address the unique needs and pressures each of us faces. Let this be a space where no voice goes unheard and no concern is left unaddressed. I urge the House and request everyone to cooperate wholeheartedly. Let us approach this discussion with openness and without any preconceived notions.

I want to express my gratitude to entire HQ team, Council members, coordinators and support staff who have made this meeting possible. Your dedication and hard work ensure that our Association remains a place of strength and solidarity. Let us engage in open discussions, learn from one another and leave with renewed confidence and clarity. I make an earnest appeal stating and am sincerely grateful and thank God for blessing us with such a remarkable headquarters team. I take immense pride in their efforts and dedication. I urge everyone to cooperate and remain fully committed to the Association, so that we can collectively strengthen this platform and achieve meaningful and impactful outcomes.

It has been observed that maximum Branches office bearer do not respond with details/data asked to Branch Chairman, Secretary for forceful discussion with higher authorities. Please do the needful whenever requested. Feedback from the branches is always essential, as it plays a crucial role in presenting issues effectively and strongly. Without inputs and details from the branches, we will not be able to adequately represent these points before the higher authorities. This is not a complaint but a sincere request to all branches to share their inputs promptly so that we can address matters in a fruitful and constructive manner.

During my tenure as President since July 2023 to date I have observed that Branches are more involved in differences amongst members and themselves and make no serious thoughtful deliberations with regard to profession related issues. Unity is important and in absence of unity department take upper hand. We should resolve our differences between ourselves amicably and be united for the cause of our profession.

8. Today we will discuss the letters received from Branches for financial help from MES BAI Service Trust. I would like to share some facts of MES BAI Service Trust. There is an issue that I have been contemplating whether to share or not, but I feel it is important to bring it to everyone's attention. As per norms, the trust body meetings should be conducted quarterly. However, no meeting was held for the last 4 years and 5.5 months. After considerable persuasion, the last meeting was finally held on 24th June 2024, the first since 7th Jun 2020 a gap of 4.5 years. Ideally, 18 meetings should have taken place during this period.

This prolonged gap has significantly derailed the objectives of the trust. I am not blaming anyone, but I sincerely urge that we take the necessary initiatives to ensure the trust fulfills its purpose, particularly for the welfare of the needy members who seek assistance.

In current tenure we have opened many branches. Today we will discuss revival of defunct MES BAI Branch at Kargil.

Our Association members are broadly divided in two groups with Elections being contested by both the group for each post at the Headquarters. This reflects a true democratic process embraced by all of us. However, I must point out that there seems to be a mindset within a particular group that considers it their birthright to lead at any cost. It is widely known that their approach often involved creating hurdles at every step, obstructing efforts aimed at addressing the welfare of general members and their rightful professional issues arising from the department. While I do not wish to elaborate further, such actions only hinder the collective progress of the Association and undermine its core objectives.

The Election process is scheduled to start after April in the election year. However, early engagement starting as early as October leads to an unnecessary expenditure of time and resources. This time could be better utilized to address the pressing and critical issues faced by members, ensuring their needs are prioritized effectively.

With these words, I request Hony Gen Secretary Sh Sandeep Srivastava to proceed the meeting as per agenda.

9. Item No 2 of Agenda. Confirmation of minutes of meeting of last council meeting.

Sh.Sandeep Srivastava, Hony Gen Secy stated that the minutes of last council meeting held on 21 Sep 2024 have been circulated through WhatsApp/E-mail vide circular No 12 dated 11.11. 2024. He further added that the Minutes were also uploaded on website. If council approve minutes of the last month's council meeting be treated as read and confirmed. No objection has been received from any one.

After detailed discussions minutes of the last council meeting were confirmed by the council unanimously.

Sh G.S Mago, President announced that Minutes of the last Gwalior Council Meeting passed by the Council by voice vote, is approved and taken on records.

Sh.Sandeep Srivastava, Hony Gen Secy thanked the President and stated that I would like to begin by reiterating your point that this meeting is not like the proceedings of Lok Sabha or Vidhan Sabha, we are here to address meaningful and constructive issues that are beneficial to all of us. As the General Secretary of the Association, I feel it is important to share several matters of significance with the House. Unfortunately, I was unable to attend the AGM due to my surgery. However, I have reviewed the video recordings at the office and am well acquainted with the discussions that took place and request to President Sir kindly show the video of AGM in house in presence committee constituted by you or committee of all past presents. In the mean time President took the microphone from the Hony Gen Secy and requested the members of the House to maintain decorum and keep the environment conducive for meaningful discussions.

Shri Varinder Kumar Garg, Past President. Stated President Sir, with all due respect, I must object to your action of taking the microphone from the Honorary General Secretary during the meeting

Shri G.S Mago, President.. stated that both legal communication and official correspondence, as well as mobile networks play crucial role. Any disruption or issues in these areas, especially when someone is located in a different region, can have widespread implications effecting everyone involved..

Shri Sandeep Srivastava, Hony Gen Secy. Stated Dear Sir, like your question I also want to share some experiences. I was not able to attend last meeting and when I was sitting in my office I saw the video of the meeting.

Shri G.S Mago, President.. Requested to Mr Sandeep Srivastava to stop mid-discussion, suggesting that such topics should be taken up later..

Shi Sandeep Srivastava, Hony Gen Secretary. Your presence and status resonate strongly with us. We acknowledge the points you have raised and assure you that they will be thoroughly discussed. While diverse perspectives may exist across the country, I personally believe that our actions should always be guided by sense of duty and responsibility toward our motherland. Today, I find myself reflecting deeply and perhaps becoming emotional, but my conviction remains steadfast. I must work tirelessly for the country that nurtures us.

When I watch certain videos or observe the expressions on the faces of our audience, it deeply affects me. This only strengthens my resolve to improve and contribute positively.

Shri G.S Mago, President Stated that today I address the esteemed members of our community. I assure you that all matters will be handled in time and any issues will be discussed with the concerned individuals. Cooperation is essential and without it, I may be compelled to make decisions that might not be favourable for everyone.

Please ensure your agenda is well prepared and confirmed. Leadership demands clarity and responsibility and I request all members to act according to the set procedures. If any issues arise after following the procedures, we will take necessary steps to resolve them. However, if I deviate from the procedures or make any mistakes, I am willing to take full responsibility and face the consequences.

The agenda we follow is not my personal creation, it has been circulated after signed and approved by Shri Sandeep Srivastava, Hony Gen Secy and other authorized members. Everyone is welcome to share their inputs, but these must be aligned with the set timeline and protocols. As President, I am working towards positive outcome for our Association and will continue to do so responsibly.

I encourage you to present your concerns but I urge restraint in overburdening the platform with non-urgent matters. Let us work collectively to achieve results. If there are objections or unresolved issues, they must be addressed systematically within the MOA framework. As per the amendments circulated to the branches, objections raised by members will be reviewed and decisions taken accordingly.

Finally, I remind everyone of their moral duty to support this Council. Decisions will be made with due consideration, wisdom, and in consultation with the MOA. Let us all rise above personal disagreements and work together for the betterment of our organization.

Shri Varinder Garg. Shri Virender Garg ,past President addressed to President Sh G.S Mago reminding him of a prior statement made in the morning. President had mentioned that he would hear everyone's issues once the discussion on Administrative points commence. He suggested that a video recording of the AGM proceedings be run to bring transparency and to reveal the truth regarding the ongoing dispute. He also highlighted that the amendments circulated to branches remain unapproved till date. He emphasized that objections have already been received from individuals, including past and present members. He also informed that any decisions about contentious issues, especially those involving amendments, must be taken by the Chair after considering all objections and ensuring due process.

Shri G.S Mago, President. Thank you for sharing your feedback. I will ensure that the concerned parties are credited and their efforts are duly acknowledged. As per the agenda we have no alternative option at this stage. If you wish to review the video, we will address this concern with the appropriate team. All issues will be presented before the AGM and we will proceed in accordance with the suggestions provided during the meeting.

At this stage President disallow the Hony Gen Secy to deliberate further on such issues of AGM video he alongwith following members left the dais and sat on the front row in the premises.

Shri Kumar Ashok, Senior Vice President. This is council and we need approval for this matter. I request all those in favour to kindly stand up and raise their hands. Based on the count, we have received 90% of the votes in favour.

Shri Varinder Garg. Sir, it seems that President has set his own parameters for approving or disagreeing with matters. With due respect, I must say that this approach is causing inconvenience to the members. President, it is your moral duty to form a committee comprising 5 to 7 members to address such concerns. Additionally, the video recording of the proceedings should be shared on WhatsApp for transparency. Decisions should be based on unbiased reviews, sometimes they may favour leadership and at other times , the common members. This will ensure fairness and trust in the process

Shri G.S Mago, President. Till date no decision made like this and in future also no decision will be made.

Shri Praveen Mahana, Past President. Till now, we have not heard from anyone that President is providing unnecessary benefits. If they can achieve 18 Patron Members, than we promise we can achieve 25 Patron members. Sir, can you please share the parties involved in the clip? It seems like you are withholding it. Since the video recording is already going on, kindly show the footage and let the truth come out. I request that a committee of senior members be formed, with members acceptable to all and sundry. Let the members see what transpired. Decisions cannot be made unilaterally in this manner.

Shri G.S Mago, President. Disagree with the views as my opinion as per proceedings.

Shri Praveen Mahana, Past President. Asked for making the said video recording in public.

Shri G.S Mago, President. Assured that it will separately be discussed.

Shri Lalit Goel, Chairman, Delhi Branch There should be discussion about how to enroll new members but we are discussing how changes MOA.

Shri. Premnath Roy, Council Member, Barrackpore Observed that President is listening to everyone that is why they are getting advantages and disturbing. You are requested to take necessary action against them.

Shri Anil Tomar, Council Member, Delhi Branch. During the recent proceedings, certain actions taken by our Past President have left a lasting negative impression. As senior members of our Association, they were expected to act with responsibility and wisdom. However, their behavior which seemed aimed at inciting discord, was deeply disappointing.

Today, it has become evident that such actions were detrimental to the harmony of our association. Furthermore, it is concerning that individuals who once held positions such as President or joint Secretary are now leaving their posts. This creates a leadership vacuum, raising the question of who would be the most suitable candidate to assume these critical roles moving forward.

In the light of these developments, I urge the House to deliberate on identifying and assigning the right individual's to these positions while addressing the actions of the past leadership. Accountability and careful consideration of future appointments are imperative to maintain the integrity of our association.

After consideration council accorded the approval unanimously for the requests of all 23 Members for upgraded of their membership status to Patron membership status.

Item 4(d) of Agenda. To consider show cause notice/termination of MESBAI membership of Sh Atul Parashar of Dehradun Branch.

On 19th October 2024 at 10:41 PM , Shri Atul Kumar Parashar of Dehradun Branch posted vulgar and anti-social comments directed at the President and office bearers of the Association in a public forum, specifically the "MES Contractors' Forum"WhatsApp group. A virtual meeting of all HQ office bearers of MES BAI (2023-2025) was convened on 20th October 2024 at 1800 hours chaired by President MES BAI Sh G.S Mago. All 15 office bearers participated in the meeting. After an exhaustive discussion , it was unanimously agreed that his vulgar and anti-association posts are utterly indefensible. In the interest of Association, President MES BAI expelled him from membership of the MES BAI (Regd) as an Ordinary Member of the Dehradun Branch effective immediately from 21st Oct 2024. Consequently, his firm, M/s Rampati Engineering Services was also expelled.

A Show cause notice "as to why his firms's membership should not be permanently terminated from MES BAI" was earlier served to Sh Atul Kumar Parashar and directed to respond the notice within two weeks. Sh Atul Parashar has been frequently requesting for documentary evidence for the mistakes committed by him rather to reply to Show cause notice vide email dt 23.10.2024, dt 12.11.2024 and 14.11.2024. The reply submitted by Sh Atul Kumar Parashar was reviewed and found unsatisfactory.

The matter was discussed in details in the Council. After due consideration with an unanimous voice vote approved the termination of Sh Atul Kumar Parashar's membership from MES BAI.

Item 4(e) of Agenda. To consider Show cause notice issued to Sh Ramvir Singh (M/s Rahul Construction Co.) of Agra Branch.

On 23rd March 2024, Sh Ramvir allegedly manhandled Shri AK Upadhyay, Hony Secretary, MES BAI, Agra Branch. Sh AK Upadhyay provided details of incidents with documentary evidence duly signed by members of concerned branch and recommended by Chairman and VP of Central 'A'. This behaviour is unacceptable and constitutes serious misconduct.

Due to the facts mentioned above, in terms article 10 (vi) (a) of MOA a show cause notice is issued as to why his membership should not be terminated for anti Association activity vide HQ MES BAI letter Ref No MBI/Agra/06/2024 dated 05 Nov 2024.

Council after considering the manhandling with Shri AK Upadhyay by Shri Ramvir Singh (M/s Rahul Construction Co.) accord approval with an unanimous voice vote for termination of his membership from MES BAI.

Item 4(f) of Agenda. To consider matter of opening of new branch at Barmer.

President shared that the Builders of Barmer Military station are desirous of joining our fraternity by opening a new branch there. List of 32 Members have been received by this HQ. Out of which 27 are ordinary members and 05 are Associate members.

He requested council to accord approval in principle for opening of branch at Barmer. On receipt of application forms alongwith subscription fees, necessary action will be initiated by HQ

The opening of new branch at Barmer was approved by the Council after considered unanimously.

Item 4(f) of Agenda. To consider matter of opening of new branch at Nasirabad.
